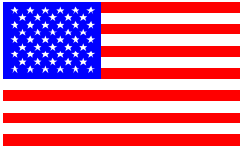

PSAT REGISTRATION: All sophomores will take the PSAT on Wed. Oct. 11th. There will be no charge for Sophomores. Any Freshmen or Juniors who wish to take the PSAT must register with the Bookkeeper starting on Monday, Sept. 18 thru Thursday, Oct. 5. The cost is \$16 per student. There will be no late registrations. If you miss the closing date, you cannot register and will not be able to test at Barlow. The PSAT is given only ONE TIME PER YEAR. Juniors, the PSAT is your one and only chance to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship.
