Classes offered (tentative) are listed below: (Class registration may be cancelled because of insufficient enrollment, lack of space, or the unavailability of a teacher.)

Students will not repeat a required class at Barlow if they have failed a semester due to budget constraints. Students that have earned a failing grade in any of the following classes qualify for summer school.

English 102, English 3-4, English 5-6, Physical Science, Biology, Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 1.5, Government/Economics

Attendance & Discipline:

Regulations in the Barlow Student Handbook apply. Students withdrawn due to discipline or attendance reasons forfeit credit and tuition.

Daily attendance is critical and the following will be enforced fully:

1. Missing a full class period or more than 20 minutes of a class period counts as one absence.
2. Missing part of a class period counts toward absences as indicated: **(Do not call Barlow to excuse absences.)**

Late Arrivals & Early Departures:

- a) Missing class 1-10 minutes = $\frac{1}{4}$ absence
 - b) Missing class 11-20 minutes = $\frac{1}{2}$ absence
 - c) Leaving class at any time for longer than the teacher permitted, or leaving class at any time without permission = $\frac{1}{2}$ or full absence at teacher discretion.
3. If, through absences, late arrivals or early departures, 3.0 absences (or more) are accumulated, then you will be withdrawn with an F grade. **Tuition will NOT be refunded.**

Dress Code:

Summer school adheres to Sam Barlow High School's dress code (*i.e. No hats/hoods, respectable short and skirt lengths including tops.*)

Registration & Tuition:

Students should contact their counselor for more information and to pick up registration materials. Payment to the bookkeeper is required to enroll in summer school. (\$100 per class/\$75 per class for free/reduced). Enrollment is a first come first served basis. Payment can be paid online from May 15 – June 28 until 5:00pm with a credit card. Transportation: GBSD does not provide transportation for summer school.

Students are required to have a contact phone number on their enrollment form so a parent can be reached or a message can be left on Friday, June 30 if changes are made to their summer school schedule (i.e. insufficient enrollment, lack of space, or unavailability of a teacher).

Students should plan to arrive at 7:30 am on Wednesday, July 5 outside the main office for first period unless they receive a phone call stating that they have only a period 2 class. Please use the main entrance (302nd Ave) to drop students off and pick them up. Student drivers should park in the student lot by the gym/pool for access to summer school.
